

Vinyl Installation Instructions

Please follow the instructions below when applying your vinyl. We advise waiting for up to a month before applying your sticker to a newly painted wall.



1) Your vinyl will arrive in 2/3 layers. The backing of the vinyl, the vinyl itself, and the application tape (if selected). Take the vinyl and position it where you want it on your wall. Tape it momentarily with masking tape.



2) Starting from the top, start to remove the backing from the vinyl using a scalpel or scissors. As you lay the vinyl back onto the wall it still start to stick. Be gentle, use a squeegee to stick the vinyl to the wall, removing any creases.



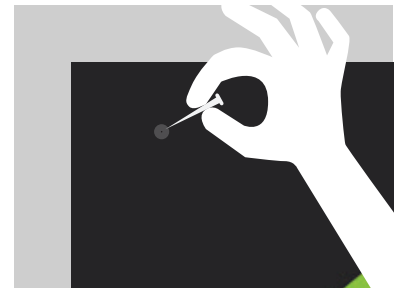
3) Remove the masking tape as you go. Once the top of the vinyl is applied, work downwards, slowly removing the backing and using the squeegee firmly to apply the vinyl to the surface. For larger vinyls we suggest 2 people.



4) Repeat step 3 until all the vinyl is stuck to the surface. If you've ordered a vinyl with application tape, now is the time to remove that. We suggest again that you go from top to bottom.



5) Take care removing the application tape, making sure the vinyl stays stuck to the wall. If it's a large vinyl, cut the application tape as you go. Use the squeegee on any parts of the vinyl that have come loose.



6) If you see any bubbles in the vinyl where air/dirt may have trapped, we suggest you use a pin and not a blade to remove. Voila! Your vinyl is now securely stuck to the wall for you to enjoy!
